



What is the Emili Pujol Campus?

The Emili Pujol Campus is a program designed for the physical and psychological development of classical guitarists through the study of guitar and the exploration of mind-body balance. The program is based on the pedagogical philosophy of the master Pujol and includes residencies in a rural and natural environment where participants can also discover the local heritage and gastronomy.

Who was Emili Pujol?

Emili Pujol i Vilarrubi, born in La Granadella in 1886 and died in Barcelona in 1980, devoted his life to the guitar. He first dedicated himself to studying and performing the instrument, then went on to become a researcher and musicologist, and later a composer and teacher. He delved into the world of early music and discovered a valuable Renaissance repertoire that had been hidden for centuries. He published a guitar method that builds on the principles of Francisco Tárrega's school, filtered through his personal experience as a performer, composer, and teacher at the Barcelona Conservatory, the Accademia Musicale Chigiana in Siena (Italy), the Ecole Normale de Musique in Paris, and the Lisbon Conservatory.



Who organizes?

The Campus is organized and produced by **Illuminario Association**, the artistic coordination of the **Cercle Guitarrístic a Catalunya**, with funding from the **European Next Generation Fund of the European Union within the Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan** and the institutional support of the **Diputació de Lleida**, the **Institut d'Estudis Ilerdencs**, the **Department of Culture of the Generalitat de Catalunya**, the **Ajuntament de Torrebesses**, and the **Dry Stone Interpretation Center**.

Where does it take place?

It takes place at the **Dry Stone Interpretation Center**, in the town of Torrebesses, where the master Pujol lived and spent time at his summer farmhouse, Mas Janet. The facilities and spaces are adapted both logically and technologically, in a rural environment and in direct contact with nature.

When is it held?

It takes place during the summer season, with emphasis on the dates of late July, August, and early September. This second edition will be held from **Monday, July 24th, to Thursday, July 27th, 2023**.

Participants targeted

The Campus is designed for the participation of students, teachers, or amateur/professional musicians, and is divided into 3 modules:

1. **PHYSIOTHERAPY AND PILATES:** Physical & ergonomic body work.
2. **PSYCHOLOGY AND NUTRITION:** Mental work & nutritional awareness.
3. **GUITAR AND EARLY PLUCKED INSTRUMENTS:** Individual/group masterclasses, active/passive listeners.

- **Monday 24/JUL | Morning (9.30-10am): INAUGURATION** - Accreditation of participants and course presentation with breakfast.
- **Monday 24/JUL | Morning (10am-2pm): PHYSIOTHERAPY (4h)** - Ergonomics, performance, body awareness and injury prevention.
- **Monday 24/JUL | Afternoon (4-7pm): GUITAR (3h)** - Technical and aesthetic workshops through the pedagogical philosophy of master Emili Pujol. Individual classes and participation as a listener.
- **Tuesday 25/JUL | Morning (10am-2pm): ROUTE AND CULTURAL VISIT (4h)** - Route through the dry stone landscape and monumental heritage, oil mill, ethnological museum visit.
- **Tuesday 25/JUL | Afternoon (4-7pm): GUITAR AND EARLY PLUCKED INSTRUMENTS (3h)** - Technical and aesthetic workshops through the pedagogical philosophy of master Emili Pujol + Practical learning of antique instruments. Individual classes and participation as a listener.
- **Wednesday, 26/JUL | Morning (10am-2pm): PHYSIOTHERAPY AND PILATES (4h)** - Improvement of physical activity, warm-up, preventive exercises, performance, posturology applied to the instrument, and action in case of injury urgency.
- **Wednesday, 26/JUL | Afternoon (4-7pm): GUITAR (3h)** - Technical and aesthetic workshops through the pedagogical philosophy of master Emili Pujol. Individual classes and participation as a listener.
- **Thursday, 27/JUL | Morning (10am-2pm): PSYCHOLOGY AND NUTRITION (4h)** - Management of stage stress and anxiety, origins and treatment. Nutrition: what/when/how to eat.
- **Thursday, 27/JUL | Afternoon (4-7pm): GUITAR (3h)** - Technical and aesthetic workshops through the pedagogical philosophy of master Emili Pujol. Individual classes and participation as a listener.


