## REGULATIONS

### XVII International Drumset Playing Competition "YOUNG DRUM HERO"

27-28 October, 24-25 November 2023

#### § I

1. The Organiser of the "Young Drum Hero" Percussion Ensemble Playing Competition, hereinafter referred to as the Competition, is the Centre for Artistic Education, whereas the co-organisers of the Competition are the F. Chopin State Music School No. 1 and No. 2 in Opole and the Polish Percussion Society with its seat in Opole. It takes place as part of the XXVIII International DRUM FEST Festival.
2. The preliminaries for participation in the Competition - on the basis of the recordings sent by the participants - will be held on 27-28 October 2023, whereas the Competition itself will take place on 24-25 November 2023 in the Exhibition and Congress Centre in Opole
3. The aim of the Competition is:
  - to raise the level of teaching of playing the drum set,
  - to compare the skill levels of young people learning to play the drum kit in different countries,
  - to motivate young drum kit enthusiasts to improve their playing skills through competition,
  - giving talented young people the opportunity to present themselves online and to confront their skills in front of an audience and a world-renowned jury,
  - promoting talented young people,
  - increase young people's interest in playing percussion.

4. The competition is addressed to students of music schools of the first and second degree, students of music academies, as well as amateurs and independent learners from Poland and abroad.
  5. The competition is divided into three age groups:
    - Group I - participants aged up to 14 years,
    - Group II - participants aged 15 to 18 years,
    - Group III - participants aged 19 to 23.
- Membership of the age groups is determined on the basis of the year of birth. 6.
6. Competition auditions are held in two stages with the participation of the audience. The order of presentation of performers is decided by the co-organisers.

## § II

1. Each participant of the Competition preliminaries is obliged to complete an application at [www.psmopole.eu/percussion-competitions](http://www.psmopole.eu/percussion-competitions) by 15 October 2023.
2. The application form should be completed in Polish or English. Also all correspondence related to participation in the Competition should be formulated in Polish or English. Failure to meet the above conditions may be grounds for rejection of the application.
3. Each participant of the Competition preliminaries is obliged to send a recording containing any 2 solo or ensemble pieces in any genre of music, the total duration of which does not exceed 10 minutes.
4. The recording must be submitted by 15 October 2023 using the link provided on the website [www.psmopole.eu/percussion-competitions](http://www.psmopole.eu/percussion-competitions) - one of the following: YDH ELIMINATIONS GROUP I - ADD RECORDING HERE or YDH ELIMINATIONS GROUP II - ADD RECORDING HERE or YDH ELIMINATIONS GROUP III - ADD RECORDING HERE.
5. The recording referred to in point 3 should be made and uploaded according to the following guidelines:
  - using a camera, smartphone, computer or tablet;
  - profile shot of the participant (visible camera), good lighting;
  - recording in .avi, .mp4, .mov, .mkv format. using H.264 or H. 265.
  - files should not be packaged in .zip or .rar archives;
  - no editing of the material within individual works or parts thereof;
  - the responsibility for the final shape and technical quality of the recording lies with the participant.

6. Eliminations will take place on 27-28 October 2023, as a result of which the Jury consisting of outstanding Polish and foreign musicians will select the participants of the first stage on the basis of the submitted recordings.
7. Participants in the preliminaries will be informed by e-mail by 30 October 2023 about the results of the preliminaries, in addition, the list of participants in the first stage of the competition will be posted on the website [www.psmopole.eu/konkursy-perkusyjne](http://www.psmopole.eu/konkursy-perkusyjne). Also, the schedule of the auditions of the first and second stage will be announced by 30 October 2023.
8. In the first stage, participants will present any piece of music lasting a maximum of 8 minutes.
9. Participants are qualified for the second stage of the Competitions by the Jury on the basis of the scores obtained in the first stage. They will be given the title of finalists.
10. In the second stage, participants will perform two songs with backing tracks or one song with backing track and a solo show. In both cases, the total duration of the presentation should not exceed 10 minutes.
11. Exceeding by a participant the presentation time limit referred to in par. 3, 8 and 10, may result in his/her disqualification.
12. Winners of the Competitions are obliged to perform at the Winners' Concert.
13. The co-organisers reserve the right to cancel the Competition auditions in a given age group if a sufficient number of participants, i.e. at least 3, do not turn up. Acoustic .
14. The co-organisers will provide a drum kit with a professional sound system and technical support for the duration of the competition auditions, and will allow an acoustic rehearsal before the competition presentation according to a fixed schedule.

### § III

1. The Competition Jury will be appointed by the Director of the Centre for Artistic Education.
2. The Jury of the Competition will consist of outstanding Polish and foreign percussionists.
3. The Jury will assess the participants' presentations on a scale of 1÷25 points, taking into account: playing apparatus, quality of sound, technical skills and musicality, and overall stage presence of the participant.
4. A participant scoring at least 18 points in the previous stage qualifies to take part in the next stage of the competition.
5. The jury will select the winners and award participants according to the following criteria:
  - The Grand Prix winner is the participant who received 25 points in the second stage.
  - The 1st place winner is the contestant who received at least 23 points in the second stage, while scoring fewer than 25 points.

- The 2nd place winner is a contestant who has received at least 22 points in the second stage and fewer than 23 points at the same time.
  - The 3rd place winner is the participant who received at least 21 points in the second stage, at the same time fewer than 22 points.
  - Distinction is awarded to the participant who received at least 20 points in the second stage, at the same time less than 21 points.
6. Students/students and relatives of Jury members may not participate in the Competition.
  7. The distribution of prizes shall be decided by the Jury of the Competition.
  8. The Jury has the right not to award individual prizes.
  9. The decisions of the Jury are final.
  10. The work of the Jury is directed by its chairman and represents the Jury externally.
  11. Diplomas and prizes in kind (in the form of percussion accessories) are provided for the winners of the Competition in each age group. As an additional prize, the Grand Prix winner will be offered a supporting act for one of the stars of the next edition of the DRUM FEST festival. 12.
  12. Diplomas will also be awarded to finalists of the Competition who are not winners. 13.
  13. The results of the Competition will be announced after the completion of the second stage of the auditions and the Jury's deliberations.
  14. The list of laureates and all prize-winners will be published at [www.psmopole.eu/percussion-competitions](http://www.psmopole.eu/percussion-competitions).
  15. Winners of the Competition who are students of Polish music schools will receive the highest positive annual grade in the educational programme "main instrument - percussion" and will be exempted from the promotional or final examination. Winners of the Competition who are students of post-secondary music schools receive the highest positive semester grade in the relevant classes.
  16. Winners of the Competition are admitted first to public secondary schools referred to in Article 132 of the Act of 14 December 2016. - Education Law.
  17. After the Competition, the co-organisers envisage the possibility of direct consultation with the members of the Jury.

#### § IV

By entering the Competition, the candidate accepts these Rules. The candidate's notification of acceptance of the application shall be deemed to constitute an agreement between the organiser, co-organiser and the candidate on the matters governed by these Rules.

## **§ V**

Each participant of the Competitions agrees to:

1. free publication of the submitted audiovisual recordings for the purposes of promoting the Competition;
2. live transmission of the Competition auditions on a streaming platform, in accordance with the in accordance with the schedule of the Competitions
3. audio and visual recording of his/her artistic performances of works in the Competition and during the laureates' concert, and transfers all proprietary rights to these performances to the Organisers;
4. audio and visual recording of his/her image, statements and interviews given during the Competition and the laureates' concert, or in connection with the Competition or the laureates' concert, and transfers to the organisers all property rights to these statements and interviews, and authorises the organisers to disseminate his or her image recorded in connection with participation in the Competition,
5. to use the artistic performances, interviews, statements and image, both in their entirety and in freely selected fragments, to make adaptations, abridgements, alterations and translations and declares that such use shall not be considered prejudicial to his/her good name. At the same time, the participant gives permission for the artistic performances, statements, interviews and images referred to in section 1 above to be labelled with his/her name.
6. Responsibility for respecting the copyright of the works performed shall rest with the participant in the Competition.

## **§ VI**

1. Participants shall bear the costs of travel to and from Opole and the costs of accommodation and meals during the Competitions.
2. The Organisers do not act as intermediaries in obtaining visas for participants in the Competitions. At the request of interested participants the co-organiser of the Competitions will send the relevant certificates of participation.
3. Participants of the Competitions should have health insurance for the duration of their stay in Poland in connection with the Competitions.

## **§ VII**

In all matters not falling within the competence of the Jury, the organisers have the right to make decisions which are irrevocable and non-appealable.

## § VIII

1. Any doubts regarding the provisions of the present Rules will be resolved based on the Rules and Regulations drawn up in the Polish language.
2. Any matters not addressed in the Rules and Regulations shall be governed by Polish law.
3. Any legal dispute will be resolved by the Polish court.

## § IX
